#### **NEW CLASSES!**

### College Guidance Class

This class introduces us the process of college admission in the US, including technical terms associated with it, such as liberal arts college, university, early action, early decision, honor program, distribution requirement, core curriculum, rolling admission, consortium.

#### College Essay Class

Like its name, this class guide students to writing college application essays.
